### Boeing Information on Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Boeing's Chief Medical Officer and the company's International Health Services team is continuously tracking health conditions using the guidance of the [World Health Organization](#) and the [U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention](#). Boeing also continues to adapt and evolve its emergency management procedures to address the ongoing coronavirus outbreak. The safety of Boeing employees and their dependents in affected regions remains a top priority.

Like many other organizations, we are also focused on:

#### **Workplace Safety**

Increasing and enhancing cleaning of high-touch areas such as cafeterias, shuttle vehicles, restrooms, light switches, door handles, railings and elevators.

Minimizing the number and frequency of face-to-face meetings with larger groups in areas with active coronavirus transmission.

Encouraging virtual meetings whenever possible, including candidate interviews.

Limiting large meetings requiring international travel to business essential to reduce the risk of travelers being subject to unexpected quarantine as travel restrictions change.

Communicating that employees have the option of participating in meetings by phone based on

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## Travel

Continuing to restrict travel to locations with extensive outbreaks, including China, South Korea and Italy.

Ensuring all travel is business essential and closely review the number of attendees needed.

Informing travelers of the potential for flights to be suspended with little notice, quarantines issued by the country government and/or travelers can be restricted from entry.

Communicating that employees with significant medical conditions should talk with their physicians and consider postponing international travel to areas with an outbreak.

Communicating that employees can opt-out of travel based on their personal risk decisions.

## Responding to Confirmed COVID-19 Cases

If an employee tests positive for coronavirus, we respond quickly in coordination with public health departments. Boeing takes a number of steps including determining if any other employees had potentially been exposed and temporarily removing them from the workplace as a precaution.
